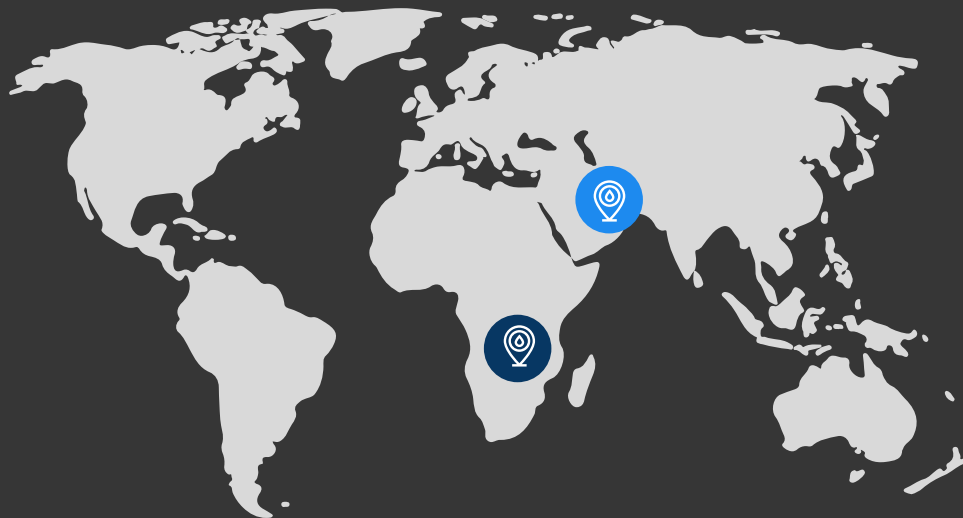

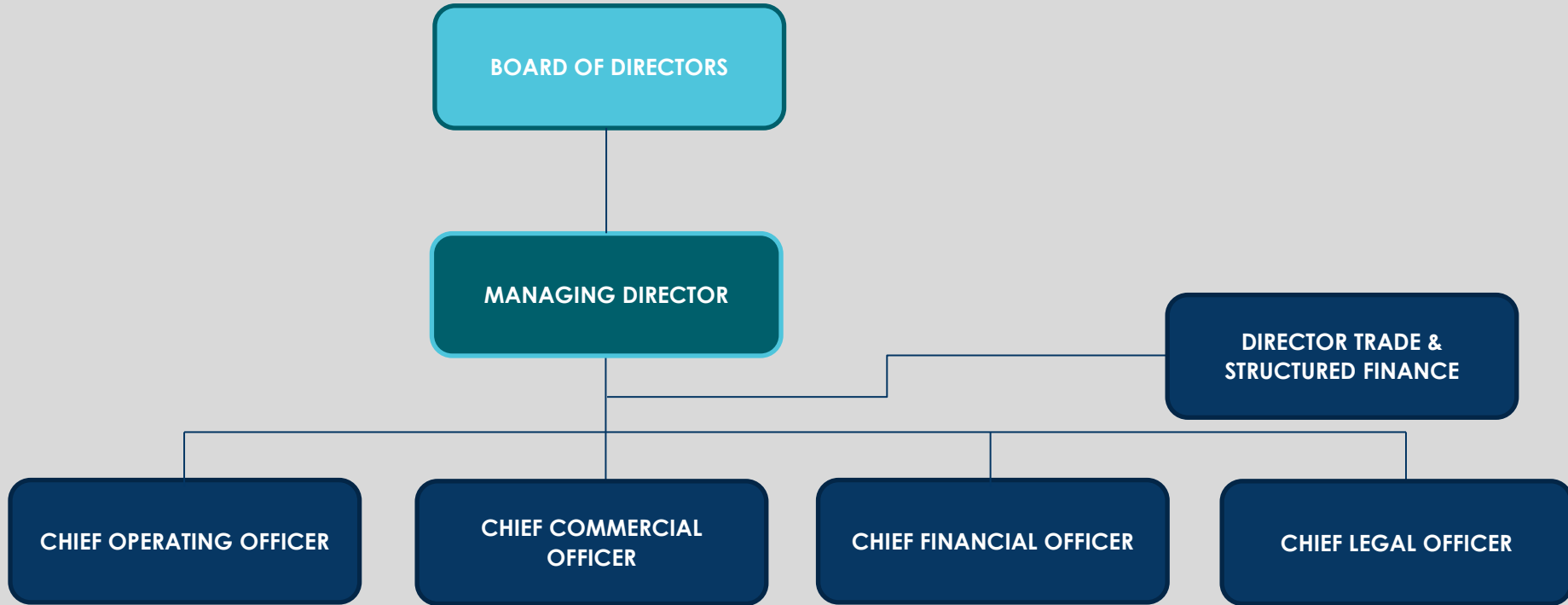
ROSETA CHABALA

47m liters a month with a sizeable portion consumed by manufacturing and mining

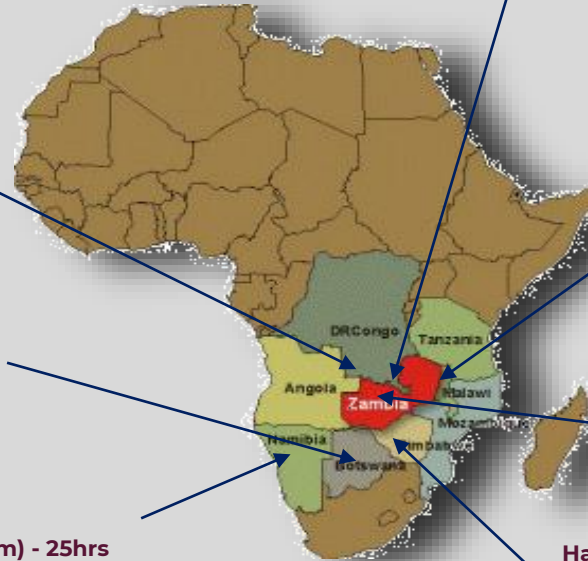
Windhoek (2,093 Km) - 25hrs
